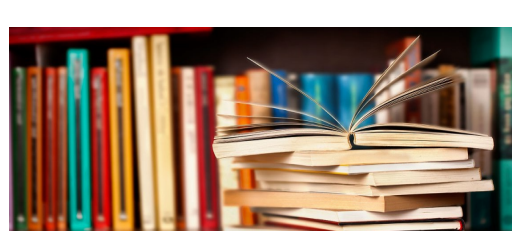
Our School Counselors are currently working on registering students for the 2018-2019 school year.
