4. MYP (Middle Years Programme) Shelley Allen
Working out the details for how we can still do the MYP awards night. It will probably be a virtual MYP awards night. Students are doing an awesome job with service reflections.
5. Community School Facilitator Geralynn Barney
Getting food bags out to our students, including extra large food bags for spring break.

6. Report from Counselors Amy Skelton
Counselors are working hard to help students during this difficult time. Counselors have created a CANVAS course for all Midvale students to help students and provide extra support.
7. COVID-19 Closure Update Mindy Robison
When the closure started we put together packets with review materials for all students. We have now loaned 500 chromebooks to students who need technology to access online learning. We are working

on getting more hotspots for students who are in need. We are now completely online. Everything is on Canvas. By the end of this week we will be contacting any student who has not accessed Canvas. Next week is spring break. There will be no new material posted on Canvas until after spring break. Weekly deadlines instead of daily deadlines on Canvas is appreciated. Communication has been good. We will not have RISE data for this year. So we do not know how this will impact TSI. We are having conversations with the state. Mindy will keep us updated as decisions are made.

9. Trust Land/TSSA Budgets

We have less than 10% carry over in our TSSA budget. This puts us in a good spot. We will continue to support interventionists with our Trust Land budget. Additional chromebooks have also been ordered with our Trust Land budget.

10. 2020/2021 TSSP Discussion & Approval

Alyssa Powers

Mindy presented to the board. They were very supportive of our plan.

Academic Goals:

Math Goal: 60% of students will meet or exceed expected growth rates on the Mathematics Inventory (MI) in the 2020-2021 school year.

Literacy Goal: 75% of students will meet or exceed expected growth rates on the Reading Inventory (RI) in the 2020-2021 school year.

School Climate Goals:

During informal and formal observations, 80% of the positive to corrective feedback will be at least 3:1 ratio by May of 2021.

Wellness Goal: By May of 2021, attendance will increase quarterly by 5% as measured by the Early Warning System (EWS), through implementation of after school programming, counseling supports and the social emotional curriculum, Second Step.

Discussion about attendance being used to measure the wellness goal. It was concluded that attendance is a way we can measure the goal based on the data we have. Our action plan is the strength of the goal. Lindsay offered to research additional ways to measure wellness goals.
