## 2020 - 2021 Midvale Middle's Return-To-School Plan

<b>Required throughout the School</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Face coverings must be worn except for eating and drinking and special classes.</li><li>• Physical distancing will be required when possible.</li><li>• Hand sanitizing/washing stations have been strategically placed in the building.</li></ul>
<b>Entry/Exit &amp; Transportation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Front doors will open at 7:15 a.m.</li><li>• Main hallway and bus doors will open at 7:30 a.m.</li><li>• Entry/Exit doors will be propped open to reduce the use of high touch points.</li><li>• After School Program participants will be dismissed 2 minutes early.</li><li>• Students that need to pick up an instrument will be dismissed 2 minutes early.</li><li>• Teachers will escort classes out of the building.</li><li>• Students will be assigned seats on the bus and required to wear face coverings.</li></ul>
<b>Hallways and Stairwells</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will walk on the right side, indicated by signage and carpet.</li><li>• Students will walk on the right side of the stairs, indicated by arrows.</li><li>• Adults will be present in the hallways to remind students to stay on the right side.</li><li>• Signage will be placed throughout the school as reminders to stay 6 ft. apart.</li><li>• Hall passes will be digital and closely monitored by teachers and administrators.</li><li>• Staff will be assigned stairwells to sanitize after each passing period.</li><li>• Full sanitization and cleaning will be done at the end of each day.</li><li>• Students will not be allowed to eat or drink in the hallways.</li></ul>
<b>Classroom</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will limit contact with other students and classroom objects.</li><li>• Students will be required to stay in their assigned seat.</li><li>• Students will be asked to report safety and sanitation concerns to their teacher.</li><li>• Extra furniture will be removed from the classrooms.</li><li>• Students will sanitize their desk and chair at the beginning of each class period.</li><li>• Teachers will sanitize their equipment as often as possible.</li><li>• Each classroom will have hand sanitizer available for student and teacher use.</li></ul>
<b>Cafeteria</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Breakfast will be served from 7:15 to 7:45 a.m. with physical distancing protocols.</li><li>• To promote physical distancing we will have three lunches instead of two.</li><li>• Cafeteria employees will wear face coverings and gloves at all times.</li><li>• Sanitization stations will be set up at the entrance of the cafeteria.</li><li>• Signage will indicate the flow of traffic and physical distancing in the lunch lines.</li><li>• Students will sit on marked locations on table benches allowing for 6 ft. distancing.</li><li>• Students will be given 15 minutes to eat and 15 minutes to go outside.</li><li>• Tables will be cleaned and sanitized after every lunch.</li><li>• Food areas will be sanitized between each lunch and at the end of each day.</li><li>• Students will be asked to sanitize their hands upon leaving the cafeteria.</li></ul>
<b>Drinking Fountains</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Signage will be placed on the floor indicating a separation of 6 ft.</li><li>• All drinking fountains will be limited to water bottle filling stations.</li></ul>
<b>Lockers</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Lockers will not be used this year to reduce congregations in the hallway.</li></ul>

<b>Student Supplies</b>	<p>The school will provide each student with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Mesh Cinch Sacks (no backpacks will be allowed)</li> <li>● Chromebook</li> <li>● Barcoded badge and sticker for lunch, bus pass, and rewards.</li> <li>● Water bottle</li> <li>● In place of planners, Google calendar and Canvas calendar.</li> <li>● Digital copies of student handbook and PBIS presentations.</li> <li>● Instead of a binder, students will be provided with folders.</li> <li>● Pencil pouches with highlighters, pencils, and pens.</li> </ul>
<b>Restrooms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Labels on the floors will indicate 6 ft. of physical distancing.</li> <li>● Signage will indicate maximum capacity for each restroom.</li> <li>● High touch points in the restrooms will be sanitized throughout the day.</li> <li>● Restrooms will be sanitized nightly.</li> </ul>
<b>Chromebooks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Chromebooks will be checked out to all students the first week of school.</li> <li>● Check out will be contactless by scanning student ID cards.</li> <li>● Cleaning guidelines will be provided to students.</li> </ul>
<b>Library</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Library books will be accessed through a digital request form.</li> <li>● Books will be quarantined and cleaned before the next checkout.</li> <li>● Unfortunately for the time being, the library will be closed during lunches.</li> </ul>
<b>Gym</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Gym lockers will not be used this year.</li> <li>● Additional equipment will be purchased to minimize student contact.</li> <li>● Curriculum will be altered to adhere to State Guidelines.</li> </ul>
<b>Large Gatherings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Back to School Night will be held virtually.</li> <li>● Per state and district requirements, we will not be having large group gatherings.</li> <li>● Assemblies will be pre recorded or streamed live.</li> </ul>
<b>After School Program</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will receive a grab and go snack.</li> <li>● Face coverings will be required and physical distancing will be maintained.</li> </ul>
<b>Specific Class Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The school will follow district protocols for special classes.</li> <li>● Alternative locations will be used when needed to maintain physical distancing.</li> </ul>
<b>Special Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Student's IEPs will be provided the same opportunities as their peers.</li> <li>● Student's IEPs will be reviewed for health issues.</li> </ul>
<b>COVID-19 Guidance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Directives from the health department will be followed in the case positive test.</li> <li>● Parents will go through a symptom checklist prior to bringing a student to school.</li> <li>● Attendance rules will be adjusted to encourage parents to keep ill students home.</li> <li>● All assignments will be on Canvas for student access for any absences.</li> </ul>
