5. PTSA Updates (Parent Teacher Student Association) Rebecca Martin

Question raised about how we can get more students involved in Reflections.

6. Community School Facilitator Geralynn Barney
Due to COVID, we have more families in need. Geralynn is working to help our families in need.
We had one immunization clinic. Working on having another immunization clinic and a flu clinic.

7. MYP (Middle Years Programme) Shelley Allen
This year our TOP BRICCK focus is balanced. This month we are working on being resilient and the TOP BRICCKs balanced and reflective. Students reflected on their TOP BRICCK strengths and weaknesses. The MYP and Second Step curriculum will be taught during Trojan Time which is part of 4th period for our in person learners. Our counselors will provide the Trojan Time lessons for our online learners.

8. Report from Counselors Amy Skelton
Counselors have been working hard to meet the scheduling needs for online and in person students. They will offer the Trojan Time lessons to our online learners starting September 18th.

9. Safety Protocols Mindy Robison
Safety protocols are available on our school website.
Students are doing a great job wearing their masks. Students are doing a great job of keeping physical distance at lunch. Our procedures for in school learning have gone extremely well.

Question raised about the chromebooks being placed in the mesh bags all day. Neoprene sleeves have been ordered for every student.

Question raised about how to clean the chromebooks. The best way to clean it is to wipe it with a disinfectant spray that you have placed on a wipe or towel. Do not spray disinfectant directly on the chromebook.

10. TSI Update (Targeted School for Improvement) Mindy Robison
Data that identifies TSI schools was not collected last year due to COVID. Due to this we do not currently have a TSI plan as we are waiting for guidance from the state.

11. TSSP (Teacher Student Success Plan) Mindy Robison
The TSSP includes goals for the year and how we will spend the funding we are allocated.

Our goals are based on showing growth on MI(Math Inventory) and RI (Reading Inventory). We will need to rewrite our attendance goal. We can not have a goal related to attendance due to COVID.
